- 2. Reservation queues will not be carried over. If your reserved item has not been picked up before the transition, please re-submit your request afterward.
- 3. Loan services for newly acquired items will be suspended temporarily. Items currently on shelves remain available for borrowing.
- July 1, 2025 (Tuesday):
- · Suspend online reservation and renewal services.
- August 1, 2025 (Friday) at 6:00 PM:
- 1. The library catalog will be available in search-only mode. All borrowing and returning functions will be suspended.
- 2. Returned items during this period will be manually recorded at the circulation

desk and updated in the new system once live.

## Friendly Reminder:

For your convenience, due dates for items borrowed between July 1 and August 31, 2025, will be extended to October 31, 2025.

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We understand that this transition may cause temporary disruptions, and we sincerely appreciate your patience and support. We will work with you to move towards a new era of library services across the institute.
